To look after the kids as per recognized standards, the foundation gives special attention to the health, hygiene, mental health, education of the kids with sports and entertainment provisions. 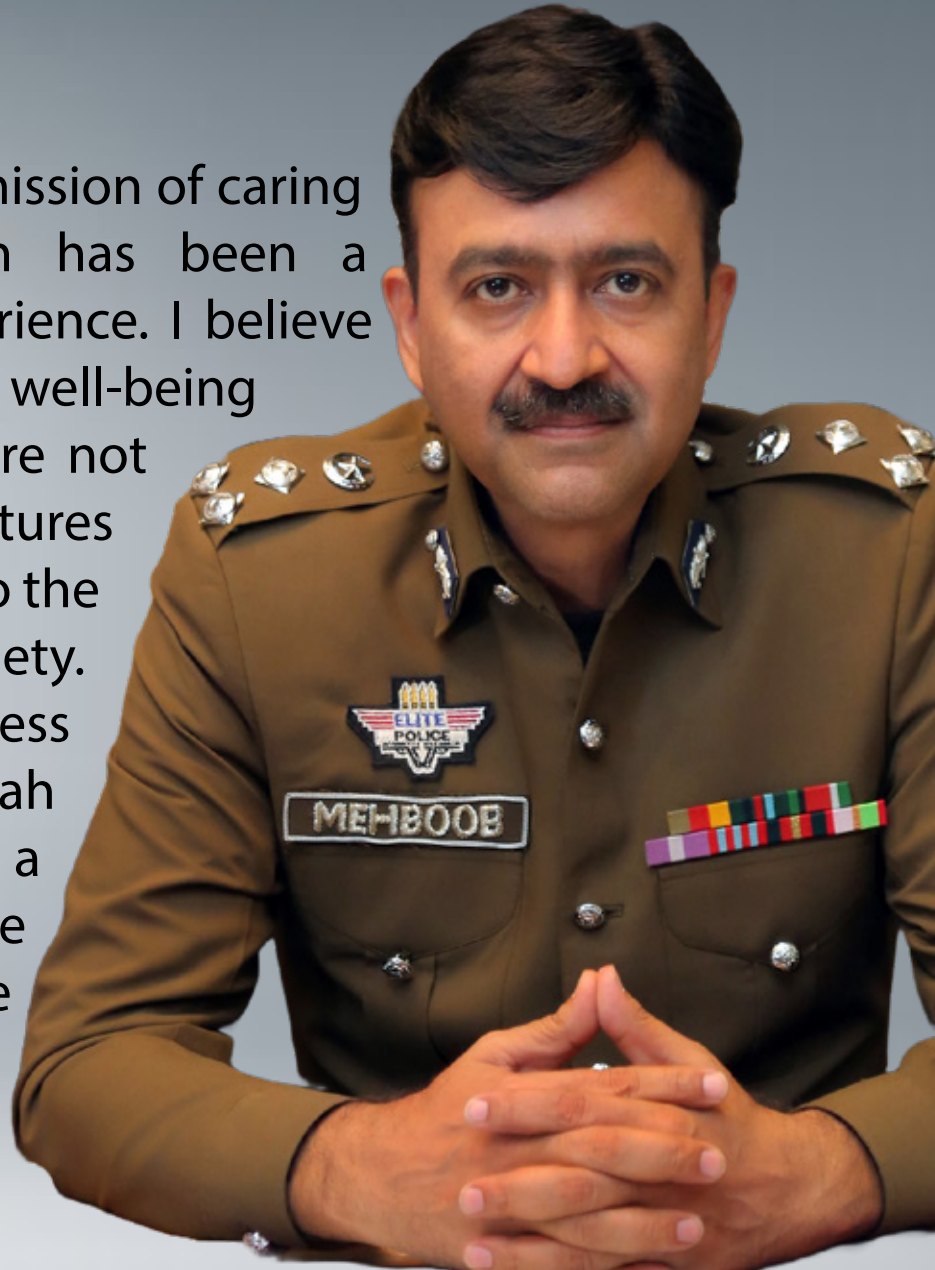
# Chairperson's Message



My father Maj (R) Rasheed Warraich, initiated the distribution of grocery among the deserving in 1995. After his death in 2009, I Sophiya Warraich and my husband, DIG Mehboob Aslam Lilla, continued this humanitarian service. We provided meal to 700 people daily, distributed groceries to 70 families every month and offered a monthly stipend to over 60 individuals, all from our own pockets. In 2021 we formally registered a foundation named Almarah Foundation. Starting from a single house in Cavalry Ground, Lahore, we began adopting orphaned children. In this short span, we now manage 10 houses in posh area Cavalry Ground and DHA on a rent basis and currently caring for 226 orphaned children, including both boys and girls 20 from minority groups. We have named these Houses as "APNA GHAR". These children live in state-of-the-art homes with all necessary amenities, receive high-quality education at Almarah Grammar School (AGS) and engage in evening hockey at Khawaja Junaid Hockey Academy, Gaddafi Stadium Lahore. The foundation's objective is to support every orphaned child in the country. By the grace of Almighty Allah, the owner of Central Park Housing Society has generously donated a 12-Kanal piece of land in Central Park Housing Society. The foundation aims to establish a four-story self-owned housing project for these children. A design for this project has been finalized. We now need funds to complete the children's complex. Your contribution towards this noble cause would be immensely appreciated. From its inception, the foundation has announced that anyone, whether donating or not, has the right to audit the foundation at any time.

## PARENT THE ORPHAN PROGRAM

This program revolves around foundation vision that

The program commenced in 2021 when a state-of-the-art Orphanage Adoption Center was started in cavalry ground, Lahore where Almarah Foundation began to provide following in-house facilities to few orphan kids, both male and female, aging from 02 to 11 years old.

We're parents of 226 orphan children who are housed in the 10 different locations of Lahore and providing them top notch facilities and care like, just like any other well settled child. The foundation commitment to caring of these children is apparent in the quality of education and health services provided to them.

The facilities ensured at the houses include:

# FEED THE HUNGRY

This program is serving society by providing food assistance to the needy and marginalized sections of the population. Currently the foundation is providing meals to 700 individuals on daily basis. Most of beneficiaries belong to lower income section of society like, daily wagers (laborers), security guards, petrol pump operators etc.



# ORPHAN FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAM

The purpose of Orphan Family Support Program is to provide support to the families of those children who lost either one or both of their parents and have lost a vital source of financial support. The OFSP is for the orphan children of underprivileged background. Under this program, the orphan children selected for provision of financial support continue to live with their mothers or a guardian in the case of the death of both parents. This program provides necessary financial support for educational and other day to day expenditures of the household for the orphan children aged 18 or below. The program's primary focus is women/girls old people aiming at providing assistance at their door step. Currently, Almarah Foundation is Distributing groceries to 70 families every month and financial (cash) help to 60 individuals.





# EDUCATE PAKISTAN PROGRAM

Almarah Foundation has a vision that every child deserves fair treatment, dignity, love and equal opportunities. To provide education to the underprivileged children, the foundation has commenced with an education system by opening a school, Almarah Grammar School (AGS), offering education classes initially from Playgroup to 10th grade. (A.G.S) is offering state of the art facilities to the children including a group of trained teachers, professionally designed curriculum, plethora of learning activities, and alluring learning environment.

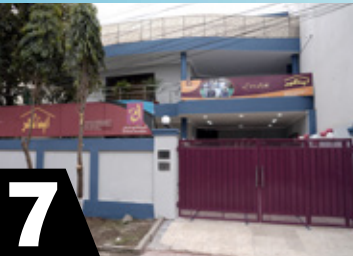

# CONSTRUCTION OF COMPREHENSIVE CHILDREN'S COMPLEX

The problem of orphan / street children is acute due to urbanization and industrialization. Due to the deaths of parents, re-marriage of deserted / widowed / divorce women, absence of love and security in the families and family disputes. These orphan and street children are left without care and support. These children are involved in rag picking; pick pocketing and participating in anti-social, criminal activities and letter on in sex abuse. In this project, more than 200 number of Orphan, Semi Orphan and Street Children will be catered. Therefore, we envisaging mainstreaming these children in the national building by providing care, support and protection in our orphan children homes "APNA GHAR". Almarah foundation is acquired a 12-Kanal piece of land to cater educational and residential needs of all these under privileged children under one roof. This dream is too big for us in our capacity and we need support of your kindness and humane approach towards these deserving children.

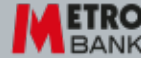
